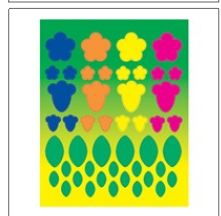

Supplies Box

- Hygloss Paper Frames- large
- Hygloss 8.5" x 11" Mighty Bright Tag-light blue
- Hygloss Floral Shapes Stickers
- Hygloss Natural Wooden Craft Sticks- regular size
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions

1. Glue a piece of Mighty Bright Tag to a Bright Frame.
2. Print out the [TEMPLATE](#) for the umbrella onto Mighty Bright Tag and cut out. To make it more colorful, cut out the middle section and handle of the umbrella from a different color.
3. Glue onto top left corner of poster.
4. Cut out a yellow sun and glue onto right top corner.
5. Decorate the bottom of the spring craft with flowers and leaves.
6. Glue 8 Popstix vertically on bottom of the poster, to resemble a fence. Glue 4 Popstix horizontally on top of the vertical ones.
7. When everything is glued in place, write the rhyme. (We chose to write half in the umbrella and half near the flowers.)

*For a giant group project:

- Use desired amount of large [Mighty Bright Tag sheets](#) (23" x 35") for the background, as well as for cutting out the umbrella and sun.
- Use [Hygloss Jumbo Wooden Popstix](#) instead of regular size.
- To create jumbo flowers, try [Hygloss 2" circles](#) or [1" circle stickers](#), and teach children how to place 1 in the center and 6 around to create flowers.
