## Bunny Puppets

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# Instructions

1. First you will need to plan the design on your Easter egg decoration. [Adult can do this for children, depending on the age of the children.] Use your pencil to sketch a simple design. Using the above picture for ideas, or your own creativity.
2. Trace part of your design with glue. Pour colored sand over the glue to cover it completely, then shake excess sand back into container or over a garbage can.
3. Now choose another part of your design to trace with glue, and cover it with another color of sand.
4. Repeat with desired number of colors of sand, until you finish coating your whole design with sand.
5. Lay flat to dry.
6. Hang these Easter decorations from the ceiling, on windows, or all over a classroom bulletin board. They make a great asset to any Easter decor!

## Classroom/ Group Activity:

Once bunny puppets have finished drying, let children wear their puppets on their hands and pretend to be bunnies. Sing their favorite Easter songs in puppet theater fashion; children can make animated voices and pretend that it's the bunnies doing the singing.
