- Hygloss 3" x 3" Pocket Cards- yellow
- Scissors
- Low temp glue gun
- Permanent marker
- Hole-puncher

1. Print the [PATTERN](#) for the luggage tags. Trace onto Craft Foam and cut out. Each tag will have 2 pieces: a solid one for the back, and one with a hole cut out for the front.
2. Cut a yellow Pocket Card slightly smaller than your luggage tag, and use a glue gun to glue to the back foam piece.
3. Glue the front foam piece on top.
4. Optional: Draw lines on Bright Card, to provide space for writing a name and address.
5. Decorate your Fathers Day craft using your creativity. Use additional colors of Craft Foam, Stickers, Markers, and zig-zag scissors.
6. Punch a hole in the luggage tag, stick a key ring through the hole, and close. Insert a 2nd key ring through the first one; the 2nd ring is for attaching to luggage.
