Instructions

1. Have adult peel off the liner from the Collage Board to reveal the sticky surface.
2. Provide children with a variety of red hearts to stick all over the Collage Board, covering it as much as they can.
3. Once children have stuck on enough hearts, finish off the color craft by pouring red Glitter over the remaining sticky parts. Shake off excess glitter.

Tips for Teachers:

- To allow even more room for creativity, provide children with other red craft items, such as ribbon, beads, buttons, foam shapes, and pom-poms. Once the collage is finished, you can do an individual practice with each student. Have him/ her point to each item on the collage, and identify it with the color first: "Red button, red heart, red ribbon etc."
- Try this preschool color activity: Have children sit in a circle while holding their red crafts. Each child gets a turn to locate a different red item in the classroom. Then he or she (proudly!) holds up his/her heart collage, and says: "My project is red just like _____".
