- Hygloss 4" Red or Pink Paper Heart Doilies
- Hygloss Red Metallic Foil Board
- Scissors
- Glue

1. Glue white oblong doily onto red metallic foil board. Cut the foil board around the doily, leaving 1/4 " of red extending on all sides.
2. Form the Valentine's card by folding the foil board in half.
3. Study the pattern on the heart doily and notice that it can be divided into three hearts: an outer heart, a middle heart and a solid inner heart. Use scissors to carefully cut the doily into these three hearts. For best results, start cutting from the bottom point of the heart. (When glued down to the surface of the card, it won't be noticeable that the heart was cut in that place.)
4. Glue the hearts onto the card. You can copy the sample picture above or arrange them in your own artistic design.
5. Of course, you can experiment with different sizes of doilies, and with as many hearts as you wish. As long as you put your heart in it, you'll succeed at creating a work of "heart"!
